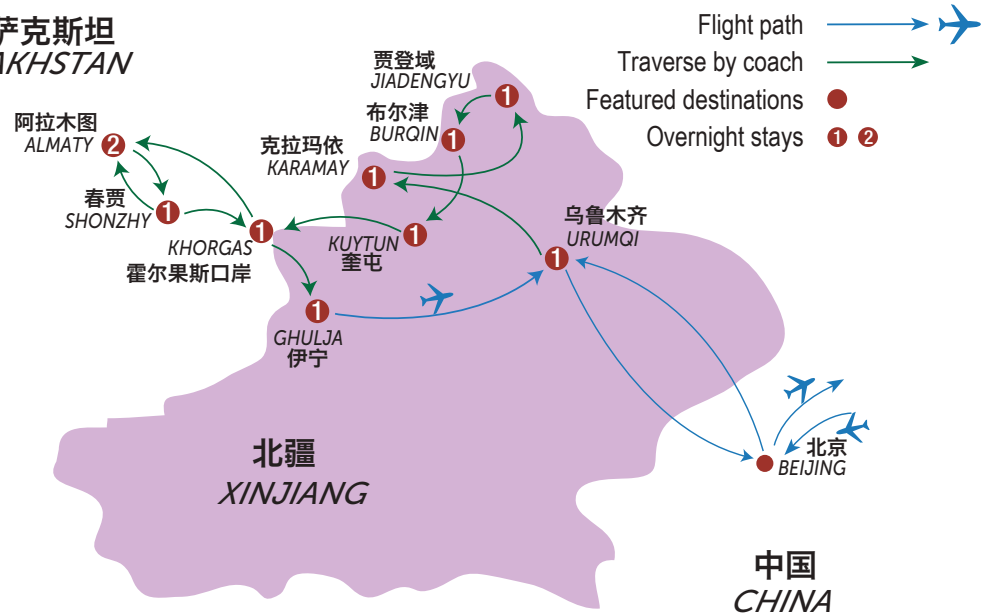

DAY 1 SINGAPORE → BEIJING

(Meal On Board)

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Urumqi (transit at Beijing).

DAY 2 BEIJING → URUMQI → KARAMAY

(Lunch/Dinner)

- **Black Oil Mountain Park** - Located In the northeast of Karamay, 2 kilometres from the city center, it is the place where the oilfields are out of the oil field. Because the crude oil overflows into a group of asphalt hills for a long time, the largest one is 13 meters high and the area is 0.2 square kilometers. The oil quality is Precious low-condensation oil. "Karamay" in Uighur is meant "Black Oil", so this natural petroleum asphalt hill is named **Black Oil Mountain**, and it has been here for hundreds of millions of years.

DAY 3 KARAMAY → JIADENGYU

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Hemu Scenic Area** (including shuttle bus) - Hemu Village is a village under the jurisdiction of Burqin County, Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region. Located on the shore of Kanas Lake in Burqin County, Xinjiang, it is the concentrated living place of the Tuva people. It is the farthest and largest village among the only remaining Tuva villages (Hemu Village, Kanas Village and Baihaha Village). 【Guests may experience horse riding back and forth to the observation deck at own expense】

DAY 4 JIADENGYU → BURQIN

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Kanas Scenic Area** (including shuttle bus 【Fish Watching Pavilion + Crouching Dragon Bay + Shenxian Bay + Moon Bay】 - Beautiful and mysterious (meaning of the Mongolian "Kanas"), you can see the clear and tranquil lake, the lake changes its colour according to the season and weather. The virgin forests of spruce, fir and Siberian larch are mixed around the lake.
- **Tuva Household Visit** - The Tuva is an ancient nation, living on nomadic and hunting. For nearly four hundred years, the Tuvans have settled on the shores of Kanas Lake. They are brave and powerful, good at riding, skiing, singing and dancing, and maintain a relatively primitive lifestyle. The quaint little village scenery is as mysterious as Kanas Lake. (Taste the Tuva homemade milk wine and enjoy the traditional instrumental singing performance).

DAY 5 BURQIN → KUYTUN

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **The Colorful Beach** - A national 4A-level scenic spot, the Colorful Beach is in the town about 24 kilometers northwest of Burqin, Xinjiang. Irtysh River whose waters reach the Arctic Ocean. The Colorful Beach has a special landform and a long-term dry zone, which is a typical colored Hill.

- **Urho Ghost City** (including mini trains) - The weathered rocks are in various forms

and shapes resembling a "window to the world", it is a unique wind-eroded geological area commonly referred to as "wind city" because of the frequent howling winds. Due to its eeriness, it is also commonly referred to as "Ghost City".

DAY 6 KUYTUN ▶ KHORGAS

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Sayram Lake** (including shuttle bus) - At the gorgeous Sayram Lake, it is no easy feat to differentiate where the lake ends and the sky begins, it's an endless stretch of blue.

DAY 7 KHORGAS ▶ KAZAKHSTAN ▶ ALMATY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Charyn Canyon National Park** - Kazakh has the world's most perfect natural and cultural landscapes. The most famous tourist attraction in southern Kazakhstan is the Charyn Canyon National Park about 210 kilometres east of Almaty. It is one of the famous tourist attractions in Kazakhstan. The terrain is like the Grand Canyon in the United States. The highest peak of the canyon is 300 metres. This is a unique talent of nature.

DAY 8 ALMATY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Park of 28 Panfilov Guardsmen** - Built in memory of the fallen heroes in the Great Patriotic War.
- **Zenkov Cathedral** - This Russian Orthodox cathedral is the only wooden cathedral in the world built without using any nails. On 3 January 1911, Almaty

experienced a magnitude-7.8 earthquake, which caused many buildings to collapse. The cathedral was left intact and is one of the few surviving buildings of the Almaty Tsarist period.

- **Independence Monument** - Located in the Republic Square right in the city centre of Almaty, the impressive monument stands at 28 metres tall, with a 6-metre-high golden warrior ruling from the top perched atop a winged snow leopard, which symbolizes the state regime on Kazakh land.
- **Shymbulak Ski Resort** - Take the cable car 3,200 metres up to the most famous scenic spot in Kazakhstan for a panoramic view of Almaty. The cable car is divided into three sections and has a total length of 4,000 metres. The ski resort is the highest in Kazakhstan as well as in Central Asia.
- **National Art Museum.**
- **Falcon Show** - Enjoy a spectacular show by specially trained hawks. Hunting with hawks by the Kazakhstan people is the most unique features of the Kazakh way of life.
- **MEGA Mall** - is the largest trade center in Almaty. It is a shopping mall where locals and foreigners often shop.
- **Hard Rock Café** - Get their classic souvenirs at your own expense.
- **Kazakhstan Cuisine with cultural dance performance.**

DAY 9 ALMATY ▶ SHONZH

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Issyk-Kul Lake** - The second largest alpine lake in the world, Issyk-Kul Lake is a fascinating green-blue stretch that extends across the high Tien Shan range and is surrounded by stunning alpine nature.

(Experience lunch in a traditional felt room)

- **Ile-Alatau National Park** - Boasting an impressive area of about 200,000 hectares, the park is also home to more than 500 species of trees, more than 400 plantations and approximately 300 species of fauna, including the snow leopard, golden eagle, Tien-Shan brown bear and many more animal species.
- **Kok-Tobe Hill** - Located in southeast Almaty, Kok-Tobe Hill, also known as Green Mountain, has a TV tower with a platform offering panoramic views of the city. Cable car service to and from the city is available.

DAY 10 SHONZH ▶ ZHARKENT ▶ KHORGAS PORT ▶ GHULJA (NORTH XINJIANG)

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- **Zharkent Mosque** - It is a magnificent building of the 19th century. The mosque was designed and built by Chinese architect Hong Feng with Chinese architectural style. The mosque also opened an Islamic school to provide children with scripture education. The mosque is decorated with national ornaments and Arabic scripts.
- **Lavender Manor** [Specially arranged between June to September depending Lavender season] .

DAY 11 GHULJA ▶ URUMQI

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Take a domestic flight from Ghulja to Urumqi (1 hour and 20 minutes).
- **Xinjiang Ancient Ecological Park** - was founded in 2005. The park gathers rare and precious natural relics and cultural essence of the ancient Silk Road: Akhal-Teke Horse Base, Ancient Petrified Woods, Millenium Populus Euphratica Forest, Black Iron Meteoric, Folk Custom Garden, Yema Art Gallery, which integrate as a unique and stunning picture scroll.

DAY 12 URUMQI ▶ BEIJING

(Breakfast/*Lunch will be own expenses)
